## **BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION & FABRICATION INSPECTION COURSE**

Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors will be offering a Bridge Construction & Fabrication Inspection course March 4-8, 2024. The target participant for this comprehensive five-day course includes bridge construction & fabrication inspectors, project managers, designers, and contractors who are actively involved with Alberta Transportation bridge construction projects. Course content will be based on the Alberta Transportation Bridge Construction Inspection Manual, Edition 3, the Bridge Fabrication Inspection Manual, Edition 1, and the Standard Specification for Bridge Construction Edition 17, 2020 (https://www.alberta.ca/bridges-and-structures-fabrication-and-construction.aspx).

Primary course objectives include the development and enhancement of bridge construction & fabrication inspection skills, the communication and interaction of the bridge construction delivery team (the Department, Inspectors, Project Managers, and Contractors) and knowledge of technical requirements related to standard specification requirements. Duties and responsibilities of the bridge construction and fabrication delivery teams within the context of conventionally delivered Alberta Transportation projects will be examined in detail. Course materials will be presented by subject matter experts.

The course will include daily quizzes and a **minimum grade of 75%** will be required for successful completion. Advanced preparation for the course will be required. The full daily course schedule is provided below.
